

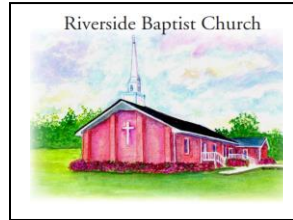

Now, let's look at a timeline of God's work over the past
38 years of ministry at Riverside Baptist Church.*

*PSALMS 126:3 - The Lord hath done great things for us;
wherof we are glad.*

April, 1981 – The church is formed and meets in the home of Rev. Perry and Mildred Godwin until October of that year when moving to the present site.

Early-Mid 1980's – Church meets in mobile unit. First sanctuary is built (current Sunday School area).

December, 1987 – *Riverside Baptist Beacon* publishes its 1st edition.

1991 – Rev. Charles Carroll, who was instrumental in the early years of the church is called home to be with the Lord.

1991 – Present Sanctuary is completed.

1994-95 – Fellowship Hall is built.

Late 1990's – Steeple and sidewalks are added.

2003 – The Rev. Perry M. Godwin goes home to be with the Lord.

2004 – Rev. Gene Payne becomes Pastor. Pastor Payne begins weekly Sunday night Worship service.

2011 – Rev. Jay Murray is called to be Pastor.

2013 – Media booth is added to Sanctuary. Ladies group begins monthly Hospice Ministry.

2015 – Rev. Ken Bartholomew is called to be Pastor.

2019 – New floors are added to the fellowship hall and the church is seeing growth. The church continues to support missionaries around the world.

Ministry Purpose: The Kammars ministry purpose is to plant churches and train men in the middle east.

Ministry Timeline: Ramzi Kammar has been a missionary to the Middle East since 1980, first planting churches in Lebanon. After being deported from Lebanon for baptizing converts, he began a church planting ministry in Jerusalem, Israel. The First Bible Baptist Church of Beit Hanina was planted in East Jerusalem. The Kammars returned to Jerusalem in November 2015 to start a new church in Jerusalem.
