Mission Aeroservices began operation in July of 1974 as a support ministry in service to independent Baptist mission boards and their respective missionary pilots scattered around the world. For those missionaries on the field we provided rapid response to calls for airframe and aircraft engine parts. The vast majority of these parts must come from the United States. As a recognized FBO (Fixed Base Operation in aviation terms) we get the very best wholesale prices and we then pass these savings on to the missionaries saving many missions dollars.

*While some are wishing for the church to somehow grow, others are preparing themselves to be instruments of God in church growth as "fishers of men" (Mark 1:17).*


